Pastor's Message

“This is my Son, the Beloved, with whom I am well pleased.” (Matthew 3:17)

Happy New Year, beloved Siblings in Christ!

Christmas Eve in Murphys was a “dark and stormy night,” with heavy rains and strong winds. But inside at Faith Lutheran, many families, friends, and neighbors gathered in the beautifully decorated worship space to sing carols and light candles against the darkness. Thank you to everyone who served in so many ways, up front and behind the scenes, to make this a warm, welcoming, and, I hope, meaningful celebration of Jesus’ birth.

In worship this month, the twelve days of Christmas are the bridge from the old year to the new, as we continue to contemplate the Word of God made flesh coming into our lives. Although we won’t have a service that day, the Feast of Epiphany caps the Christmas season on January 6, with the showing forth of Christ as the Savior of the world by the star of Bethlehem and the visit of the magi. On the first Sunday after Epiphany, we observe the Baptism of Our Lord, who was baptized alongside us sinners as “one of us.” The time after Epiphany is a “green season” of discipleship, inviting us to consider how we share this good news of great joy, that Christ is dwelling among us. Time after Epiphany ends on Transfiguration Sunday, Feb. 15.

The New Year feels like grace – a fresh start, with open possibilities, a time for setting plans and priorities. Faith Lutheran will hold a semi-annual congregational meeting after worship on February 1, to adopt the budget for 2026. Please plan to join us for this important time of considering our ministries for the coming year – how we might be a “strategically small church,” faithfully committed to worship, discipleship, and service in ways that are appropriate to our size and the resources we have, without apology or regret. What priorities we will focus on? What is God calling us to **do** and to **be** as the body of Christ in this time? What support will we need? One exciting event coming in 2026: Bishop Jeff

Johnson is scheduled to visit us on Sunday, April 19! How do we want to welcome him?

“Meal-in-a-Bag” Program for Senior Center


We are invited to fill a bag with items for a sustainable “shelf food” meal. Please check the weekly announcements for the meal ingredients this month.

Interested in Helping in Worship?


