Pastor's Message

"In the last days it will be, God declares, that I will pour out my Spirit on all flesh..." (Acts 2:17)

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

Summer is upon us, the season of rest and renewal. To celebrate summer, we will have a potluck on June 22 after worship. I hope you will join us that day and, if you can, bring a favorite summer dish to share.

On June 8 we celebrate the Day of Pentecost and the birth of the Church, as the Holy Spirit was poured out on the disciples and thousands were baptized. We yearn for that kind of Spirit power to be poured out on us, and this year's Synod Assembly theme, "Do Not Lose Heart," is addressing the challenge of being the church in this time. I spend a lot of time pondering how *we* are called to do ministry here at Faith Lutheran, with our small numbers, and I am eager to hear the keynote speaker at the Synod Regional Gathering on May 31, who will speak about church innovation. Be sure to ask Rob, Kaarn, or me what we learned, and pray for the Spirit to guide us into vital and faithful ministry.

I continue my work as Dean of our Sierra Central Valley Conference. All ten of us deans are white, as well as the Bishop and all his staff, so we are reading together and discussing an anti-racism book, *Call to Allyship*. This is important work – uncovering our hidden biases, even within our best

intentions, and teaching us how to more faithfully love our BIPOC (Black, Indigenous, and Persons of Color) neighbors and fellow believers in Christ as we love ourselves and as Christ has loved us all. Do you think we could learn from similar discussions here?...

If you are traveling this summer, I encourage you to visit a local worship service wherever you are. It is good to hear the gospel proclaimed in a different voice and different setting, and helps us to grow in our connection as the body of Christ in the world. May you be blessed with rest, refreshment, and renewal in faith this summer.

Worship in June

une is a multi-colored month in worship this year, with a different liturgical color each week:

- June 1 is the Seventh Sunday of Easter, still white of the Easter season. On this Sunday we always overhear part of Jesus's "high priestly prayer" for his followers at his last supper, just before his arrest and crucifixion.
- June 8 is the Day of Pentecost; wear **red** to celebrate the fire of the Holy Spirit!
- June 15 is Holy Trinity Sunday, another white feast day, as we contemplate the mystery of the Triune God, the holy dance of Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

June 22 begins Time after Pentecost, also called Ordi-

nary Time, the "long **green** season" hearing stories of "ordinary" ministry and discipleship. On June 29 the green season is interrupted with the lesser festival of Peter and Paul, Apostles. The color is red for the Holy Spirit working through these towering leaders of the early church. Both were martyred for their faith.
